

Beata Smarzynska Javorcik is a Senior Economist in the Development Economics Research Group of the World Bank. Her research interests focus on determinants and consequences of foreign direct investment. Her current work examines productivity spillovers from foreign direct investment, particularly those taking place through contacts between multinationals and their local suppliers. Her papers have been published in *American Economic Review*, *European Economic Review*, *Oxford Review of Economic Policy*, *World Economy* and other professional journals. She is also a co-editor of a forthcoming volume on *Globalization and Technology Transfer*.



Dr Javorcik is a Research Affiliate of the Centre for Economic Policy Research in London and a Policy Associate at the Leverhulme Centre for Research on Globalisation and Economic Policy at the University of Nottingham. She holds a Ph.D. in Economics from Yale University and a B.A. from the University of Rochester. At the World Bank she has also served as a country economist for Azerbaijan and done extensive work on transition countries, including her native Poland.
